- How are your NSG organised?
 - The chair is a revolving position reserved for company representatives
 - FFIF's Innovation Policy Manager acts as the NSG secretary
 - NSG Finland is an open platform that seeks to involve the entire RDI ecosystem relevant to the Finnish forest-based industries
 - The NSG currently meets 2-3 times a year depending on FTP's ongoing issues are input needs
 - Relevant national issues can be put on the agenda as well
- Which important national stakeholders do you reach/not reach with your activities?
 - NSG Finland has an exceptionally good reach, actively involving almost all relevant stakeholders in the forest industry's RDI ecosystem (see prev. slide)
